Attention, Archers!

Archery shooters will be pre-squadded. Please email your squad member names to Randall Nevins at rand.nevins@msstate.edu (squad of four shooters), by June 25; otherwise, you will be squadded randomly. If more than one squad per county, list each squad with names.

Attention, .22 Rifle!

Due to limited range availability, .22 rifle will begin equipment check-in at 11 a.m. on July 19 under the Southern Ionics 4-H pavilion. All other disciplines will report to their respective ranges for equipment check-in beginning at 7 a.m.
