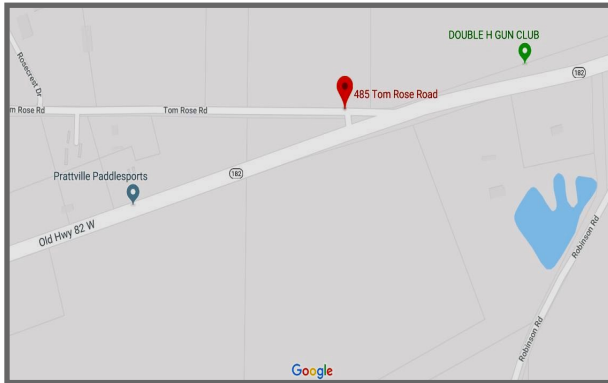
A workshop for private non-industrial forest landowners and interested professionals.
