► **State 4-H Congress/State 4-H Horse Championship Workshops & Training Opportunities**

In the next couple of months, several workshops and training sessions for upcoming 4-H horse events and contests will be scheduled. Workshops/training sessions that will likely be held in late March through May will focus on Dairy Products Judging, Meats Judging, Horse Demonstrations, Horse Judging, and other horse show-related topics. Even though we do not have a major horse show until June and July, there are still plenty of items to keep us busy.

► **Recruiting New Members**

Spend some time promoting the 4-H animal and dairy science projects. This would be an excellent time to make personal contacts with potential project members, doing a news release or a radio program, having a county meeting, organizing livestock clubs, or whatever works for you. ► **4-H Club Congress Contests**

4-H Club Congress Contests will be here soon (May 29–31). Now is the time to be lining up participation and planning county contests. Contests in the 4-H animal and dairy sciences area are Visual Presentations for seniors (four divisions included [1] beef; [2] sheep, swine, market goats; [3] dairy animals; [4] dairy products.) Other contests available are meats judging/identification contest, livestock bowl, and dairy bowl for senior members and dairy products judging. Plus there is a dairy poster contest with several age divisions. These are all excellent contests. If we can provide you with information about these contests, please let me know.

► **4-H District Project Achievement Day Contests**

4-H District Project Achievement Day Contests will be here soon (June 5-6, 11-12). Now is the time to be lining up participation and planning county contests. Contests in the 4-H animal and dairy sciences area are Visual Presentations for juniors (two divisions included [1] beef, sheep, swine, market goats; [2] dairy animals, dairy goats, dairy products). The other contest is dairy products judging for juniors. The contests will be held as follows: June 5: NE Contests, Itawamba Community College, Fulton; June 6: NW Contests, MS Delta Community College, Moorhead; June 11: SE Contests, Howard Technology Park, Ellisville; and June 12: SW Contests, Hinds Community College, Raymond.

► **Pork, Beef & Poultry Cookout Contests**

Again this year, we will have a north-half contest for pork, beef and poultry and a south-half contest for pork, beef and poultry. The contest for the north half of the state will be June 18<sup>th</sup> starting at 9:00 a.m. at a location to be determined by the State 4-H Office. The contest for the south half of the state will be June 19<sup>th</sup> starting at 9:00 a.m. at the Forrest County Multi-Purpose Center in Hattiesburg, MS. Additional information will be sent from the State 4-H Office at a later date.

► **Alert Horse Project Members About Ownership & Ethics Certification!!!**

**NOTE: The 2013 Horse Show Rule Book is finished! When it is ready, we will let you know!**

Remind your 4-H'ers and adult leaders that May 1<sup>st</sup> is ownership deadline for horses to be shown in the 2013 4-H horse shows. Also, each horse showing in the district 4-H horse shows must be accompanied by original registration certificate or official ownership form for grade horses (**BOTH DATED & SIGNED BY MAY 1<sup>ST</sup>**). Copies of registration certificate or ownership form must also be sent in with entries by district show deadline. Horses must be in the name of the 4-H'er, or in the name of an immediate family member (farm name is not eligible). Also, any youth that wishes to show in this year's District and State 4-H Horse Shows must be a 4-H member by May 1<sup>st</sup>. **The horse show entry deadline is May 1<sup>st</sup>.**

In addition, a **NEW** 4-H'er who plans to show in the 2013 District & State 4-H Horse Shows and at least one parent must have completed the Ethics Certification program by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Also, any **NEW** volunteers that assist 4-H'ers with their horses must be ethics certified by June 1<sup>st</sup>. **Be sure to wait until the State 4-H Office releases the updated volunteer certification process before certifying any adults!**

4-H'ers that are **only** competing in the non-riding contests (horse bowl, horse judging, art contest, photography contest, hippology, public speaking, and demonstration contests) do not have to be ethics certified. However, these 4-H'ers should be encouraged to be ethics certified!

An **official certificate** showing a current negative Coggins test will be required on all horses that show in district and state 4-H horse shows. These certificates will be checked and must be in possession of the exhibitor and/or with the horse at the shows. Exhibitors must also present ORIGINAL (no copy of original) registration papers at the district and state shows. If agent maintains original registration papers, agent MUST BE PRESENT at time of check in. Now is the time to be taking care of these important matters. Alert your 4-H'ers.

► **Horse Bowl**

Note that senior horse bowl contestants have a new reference starting this year. The reference is Parker Equine Science (Fourth edition) by Rick Parker - ISBN-13: 9781111138776; published January 2012.

Each county with teams is requested to submit 25 questions for juniors and 25 questions for seniors, regardless of the number of teams competing per county. These questions will be used in developing the district and state contests. **These questions must be sent via email to Dr. Dean Jousan (djousan@ads.msstate.edu) by April 1, 2013.** Questions and the correct answers must be typed, come from the official sources only and include reference source with page number.

► **4-H Dairy Poster Contest**

The theme for the 2013 Dairy Poster Contest is ***"Dairy Packs Power"***. Publication 799 contains all the information about this contest and can be obtained from Extension Supply by electronic publication ordering from Department A9. Your county winners in the three age divisions are to be delivered to a location to be sent out at soon on Wednesday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, the first day of State 4-H Club Congress for judging in the state contest. The deadline will be 11:30 a.m. Good Luck!

District and Dixie National Junior Round-Up premiums have been totaled and mailed to Jackson.

► **2013 DIXIE NATIONAL SALE OF JUNIOR CHAMPIONS**

The 44<sup>th</sup> Sale of Junior Champions was another great event for our youth involved in the Animal and Dairy Sciences Program. The Sale's committee is to be commended for the hard work that they put into this sale to make it a very successful activity. This was the 19<sup>th</sup> year in a row for the sale to gross over \$100,000. Gross total for the 42 animals sold for a **NEW SALE RECORD of \$316,913.75**. The 8 steers averaged \$11,000 per head; the 13 hogs averaged \$5,557.69 per head; the 12 lambs averaged \$5,145.83 per head; and the 9 goats averaged \$5,500 per head. In addition, buyers added \$45,413.75 to various lots in the sale. The Grand Champion Steer was purchased by Ergon, Inc., Blue Cross/Blue Shield of MS, M.G. Dyess, Inc. and Haley & Marsha Barbour for \$16,000 with another \$7,500 added for a final sale price of \$23,500. Gray-Daniels Ford and Watson Quality Ford purchased the Grand Champion Hog for \$10,000 and Joe Tally and Bruce and Tina Craft added another \$500 for a total of \$10,500. MS Farm Bureau Federation, Southern Farm Bureau Casualty Insurance Company, Tico's Steakhouse, Southern Farm Bureau Life Insurance Company and TeleSouth Communications purchased the Grand Champion Lamb for \$8,500. The Grand Champion Goat was purchased by Energy Group for a **NEW SALE RECORD of \$15,500**. An additional total of \$600 was added to this goat from Ted Cannon State Farm, Tim Fairley, Garner-Lumby Electric, Donnie Walker Mane Event Hair Designs, Sunrise Trading Post, Dr. Doug Jefcoat and Cotton & Associates. The Reserve Grand Champion Steer sold for a **NEW SALE RECORD of \$25,000** and was purchased by Tellus Operating Group LLC and Herrington Services.

The Sale of Junior Champions continues to mean a lot to our Mississippi youth livestock program. The 44 sales have grossed a very impressive **\$5,125,382.40**. The first sale in 1970 had a gross total of \$7,621.35. This outstanding activity has come a long way in 44 years! In addition to the sale of champion animals, 34 scholarships were awarded totaling \$53,500. In the past 21 years, **\$551,200** has been awarded to Mississippi youth to assist them with their college education.

The buyers, contributors, sale committee members, Extension staff members assisting with the sale, and other supporters who help make this a special event for our youth are to be commended.
