U.S. Turkey Consumption

According to USDA-ERS and AgMRC, “the United States is the world’s largest turkey producer and largest exporter of turkey products. While exports are a major part of the U.S. turkey market, domestic consumption is higher than any other country, at 16.4 pounds per person in 2012”. USDA-NASS reported that the U.S. turkey production reached 7.2 billion pounds valued at \$5.3 billion in 2014. The top five producing states are Minnesota, North Carolina, Indiana, Arkansas and Missouri.

Mississippi Turkey Farmers

Households or businesses who are planning to serve locally-grown turkeys for Thanksgiving can start looking for local turkey farms by using the following steps:

1. Using your PC, laptop, iPad or smart phone, go to <http://ms.foodmarketmaker.com>.
2. Click “Search” and type “**turkeys**”.
3. Select **Farmer/Rancher** under Basic Filters, then click **Search**.
4. Remember to specify your current location.

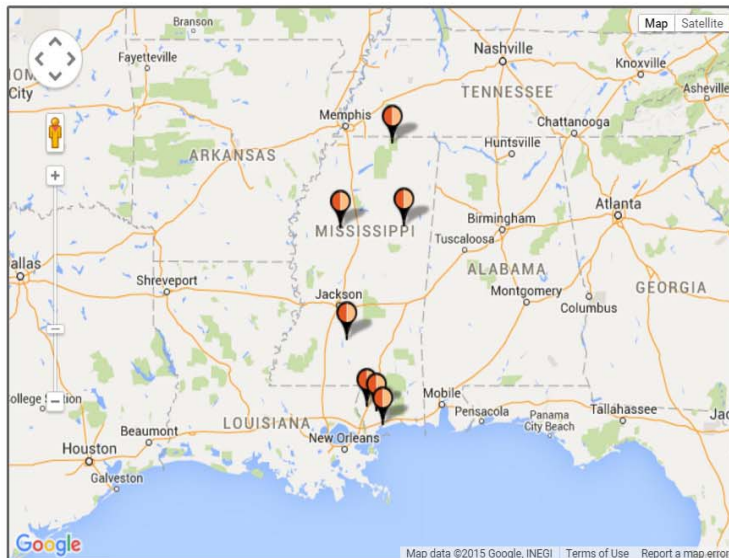
