Below I've summarized the information that has been previously released by the Public Health Laboratory regarding days/times that samples may be submitted.

ALL types of Bacteriological (Routine and Non-Routine) and Fluoride (Split and Non-Split) samples:

May be submitted to COUNTY locations Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday for delivery by courier to the Lab.

On Thursday public water systems may deliver samples directly to the Lab in Jackson by 4 pm.

Remember that these are the only times that ROUTINE Bacteriological and SPLIT Fluoride samples may be submitted.

Additional times for ONLY SPECIAL Non-Routine Bacteriological and Non-Split Fluoride samples that have been pre-arranged with Bureau of Public Water Supply staff (Charles, Jessie, or Brenda):

Submit to County Thursday and Friday for delivery by courier to Lab.

On Friday public water systems may deliver directly to the lab by 2 pm.

Please remember that water systems must contact the Bureau of Public Water Supply prior to collecting these special (boil water, resample, etc.) samples on Thursday and Friday.


