June Dairy Poster Contest

June is National Dairy Month and the 2024 poster contest theme is "May The Dairy Be With You". Posters must be 22 inches by 28 inches. It can be on posterboard or a substitute. You can not use brand names or copyrighted material (such as cartoon characters). The poster must focus on benefits of consuming real dairy products, not alternative milk beverages.

4-H Record Books - Due June 28


