Team Building

The Robot Round-Up is great opportunity for 4-H Robotineers to show off their building and programming skills at the Mississippi State Fair. 4-H'ers may work in teams of 2-3 youth to build a robotic animal to "show" at the State Fair. The Robot Round-Up will be held at the State 4-H Village.

- Register with your local Extension Agent.
- Building instructions and programming instructions can be found online and through books. Ask Mariah for resources if you need help.
- All judging will be based on a rubric. You can find a link to the rubric on the Facebook page, newsletter or request via e-mail.
- Please bring your robotic animal to the State Fair on October 14, 2023. Check-in begins at 8:30 A.M. and will continue until 9:30 A.M. Judging starts promptly at 10:00 A.M. Youth are required to stay with their robotic animals during judging. They should be prepared to present their robot and answer questions about build, design and programming. Robots must be picked up by 12:00 P.M.
- You may decorate your robot or provide a backdrop provided the decorations do not permanently mark the robot.
- Bring the family and enjoy 4-H Day at the Fair!

For the LEGO Build contest, there will be four age divisions:

• Cloverbud: 5-7-year-olds

• Junior Cloverleaf: 8-10-year-olds

• Juniors: 11-13 years old

• Seniors 14-18 years old


This is an individual contest. All participants must create a LEGO project based on something they would find or see at the State Fair. All entries must fit into a disposable aluminum pan.

The Robot Round-Up will take place on the same day. This is a team contest. Each team should be 2-4 youth. Cloverbuds will use the Dash robot, and Juniors will use the NXT/EV3/SPIKE robot to create an animal they might find at the State Fair. Please see the 4-H Robotics newsletter for rubrics and complete guidelines.
