Just a reminder to everyone that it's time to sign up for County Contests. Any 4-H member may participate. You <u>MUST</u> participate in at least one county contest (not including poster contests or the photography exhibit contest) in order to participate in Project Achievement Day or State 4-H Congress. We will also have contests that 5-7 year olds may participate in at the county level; however, these individuals are not eligible to participate in Project Achievement Day due to their age. You may compete in a maximum of <u>THREE</u> county contests; however, you must let us know by <u>March 31</u> so that we can prepare. These three contests do <u>not</u> include the Photography Exhibit contest, Poster Art contest, or Dairy Poster contest. The Shooting Sports club is off to a roaring start. They held their safety meeting in January. The Alcorn County Northeast Invitational Shooting Sports event will be **Saturday, March 24**, at CRSSA range in Glen. Equipment safety checks begin at 7:30 AM. The following disciplines will be offered: .22 pistol, .22 rifle, air pistol, air rifle, archery, and shotgun. Youth may choose two disciplines to participate in. There is an \$8.00 fee for each discipline. The Tippah Invitational will be **Saturday, March 10**, Archery and Shotgun Only. There is a \$5 fee for each discipline. This is an opportunity for youth to receive postal scores that are required to register for the district event. The district event will be held **Saturday, April 28**, in Blue Springs. Details about this event will be provided at a later date.
