## **Training**

Participants receive 30 hours of training through program discussion, demonstrations, and hands-on experience. Registration for basic training is \$50. Here are some training topics:

- Latest sewing techniques
- Current products and resources

## **Volunteer Service**

Master Clothing Volunteers will provide 40 hours of educational service in textile-related topics (home decor, heritage sewing, and others) to the community within a year from the time of the training. This service may include any of the following:

- Teaching sewing classes
- Judging sewing and clothing contests
- Presenting clothing exhibits
