OTAL OUTPUT AND VALUE ADDED IMPACTS

Forestry and the forest products industry generated more than \$62.9 million, or about 10.2% of economic output, in Holmes County. Forest-related value added amounted to more than \$22.3 million, or about 7.4% of all value added in the county. The value of all goods and services produced is defined as total output. Value added is a portion of total output and represents the creation of new wealth.

TAX IMPACTS

Forest-related economic activity contributed an estimated \$5.4 million in tax revenue for federal, state, and local governments. This total includes tax revenue of \$3.4 million for federal and \$2 million for state and local governments.
