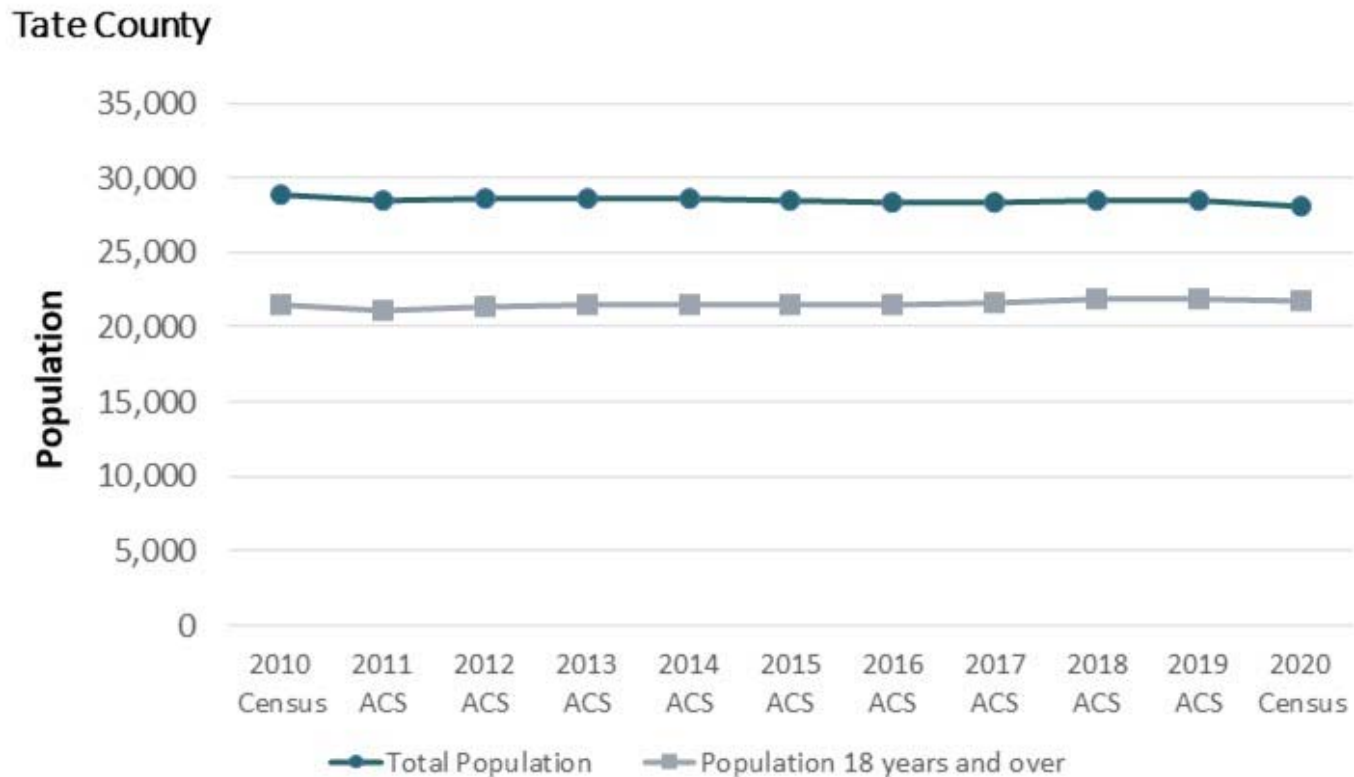


Census Populations (2010-2020)

This graphic presents the total population and the population for residents 18 years and over using data from the 2010 Census, the 2011-2019 American Community Survey (ACS) survey estimates, and the 2020 Census. If relatively large deviations between the 2020 Census and either the 2010 Census or the 2011-2019 ACS estimates are evident, you may want to consider questioning the 2020 Census counts. These deviations **could** be an indication of an error in the 2020 Census counts. Data in this report are gathered from the 2010 Census (data.census.gov), the 2011-2019 American Community Survey (ACS) 5-year Population Estimates (data.census.gov), and the 2020 Census Redistricting Data (census.gov).

Rankings are based on the calculated percentage change of the area being reported. County rankings are based on the 82 Mississippi Counties.
