SIMPLE IDEAS ON WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE YOU PURCHASE A TRUCKLOAD OF SMALL RUMINANTS!

OR, HOW TO BEST AVOID FAILURE AS A NEW SHEEP/GOAT PRODUCER

WHAT IS A SMALL RUMINANT???

SHEEP AND GOATS OR LITTLE COWS???



Ruminants include cattle, sheep, goats, buffalo, deer, elk, and camels. These animals have a digestive system that is uniquely different from our own. Instead of one compartment to the stomach they have four.



SHEEP AND GOATS ARE SMALL RUMINANTS!

REMEMBER-There is as much difference within breeds/species as between breeds/species.

HOWEVER, MOST IMFORMATION ON SHEEP AND GOATS IS RELATIVE TO BOTH SPECIES.

MAJOR DIFFERENCES:

SHEEP GRAZE. GOATS BROWSE.

GOATS REQUIRE COPPER IN THE DIET. SHEEP TOLERATE LITTLE COPPER IN THE DIET.

(AS A RULE OF THUMB SHEEP NEED NO MORE THAN 4-8 PPM IN THE DIET)

SHEEP, GOATS, AND COPPER

GOATS REQUIRE SOME COPPER IN THEIR DIET, THEREFORE!

- ALWAYS USE A SHEEP MINERAL FOR SHEEP AND A GOAT MINERAL FOR GOATS
- IF SHEEP AND GOATS ARE RUNNING TOGETHER, USE SHEEP MINERAL TO BE SAFE
- SHEEP AND GOATS DO REQUIRE MINERALS
- KEEP A GOOD QUALITY MINERAL OUT FULL TIME FOR OPTIMUM REPRODUCTIVE AND NUTRITIONAL HEALTH IN SHEEP AND GOATS

SO, SHEEP AND GOATS ARE PRETTY MUCH THE SAME ANIMAL WITH BOTH BEING SMALL RUMINANTS, AND THEREFORE CAN BE **MANAGED IN PRETTY MUCH THE SAME** FASHION. THERE ARE DIFFERENCES IN **COPPER LEVELS, AS WELL AS GRAZING AND BROWZING PREFERENCES.**

Figure out your market! How will you sell your production?

DO NOT BUY A SHEEP OR GOAT UNTIL YOU HAVE A MARKETING PLAN!

Marketing Options...

- Direct to Consumers
 - Live Off the Farm
- Through Marketing Channels
 - Special Registered Sales
 - * Traders
 - Local Sale Barn
 - Local Processing
 - Marketing Cooperative
 - Licensed Inspected Plant



Identify a market and know you will be able to sell your production at a profit before purchasing animals!!!!

Have proper facilities for sheep/goats! What is needed?

DO NOT BUY AN ANIMAL UNTIL YOU HAVE PROPER FACITITIES FOR SHEEP AND/OR GOATS!

FACILITIES..

- *** FENCING**
 - Net Wire
 - At least 48" tall
 - Barbed wire top/ bottom
 - Proper wire spacing
 - * Electric Fencing
 - High maintenance
 - Good temporary/rotation usage
- * Combinations of net and electric are best



If you can throw water through it, they can go through it! Never discount good fencing systems!

Facilities..

* Corrals *5-6 feet tall Solution Use heavy net wire or 4 X 4 welded wire *12" wide, smooth sides, slightly curved Well lighted Movement uphill * Sheds \$ 5 sq. ft. per animal Two sides minimum





Learn basic animal husbandry skills! Can you keep your animals alive?

DO NOT BUY A SHEEP OR GOAT UNTIL YOU KNOW YOU CAN MANAGE SHEEP AND/OR GOATS!

KEEPING THEM ALIVE...

Nutrition/Feeding Health Program Disease Management Seeding/Reproduction Forages/Pastures



WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW **BEFORE BUYING SHEEP/GOATS?** Know the type/kind of sheep/goat that's best for you! What breed of sheep/goat do you need?

DO NOT BUY ANY SHEEP OR GOATS UNTIL YOU HAVE A PRODUCTION DIRECTION!

SHEEP BREEDS CAN BE WOOL OR HAIR, DAIRY, ETC. GOAT BREEDS CAN BE MEAT OR FIBER, DAIRY, ETC.





Find a reputable breeder to deal with on buying animals!

DO NOT BUY SHEEP OR GOATS FROM TRADERS OR PROCREATORS IF AT ALL POSSIBLE!

BUYING SHEEP/GOATS...

- * Research breeders and operations
 - Contact breeders and ask questions
 - * Find breeders located in your area
 - Will they or can they assist you with problems?
 - How long have they had animals?
 - Do they offer any guarantee on their sheep or goats?



Have a financial plan! How do you pay for your animals?

DO NOT BUY AN ANIMAL WITHOUT REASONABLE ASSURANCE THEY WILL PAY FOR THEMSELVES!

BUYING SHEEP/GOATS...

- Review and establish a real time budget for your operation
 - Place limitations on your investment
 - Secure cash rather than borrowed money if at all possible
 - Lending institutions are not favorable to loaning money for sheep or goat operations
 - Losses are a real possibility in the industry



Know your limitations! Can you manage a lot of animals?

DO NOT BUY A LOAD OF SHEEP OR GOATS UNTIL YOU FIRST MANAGE A FEW SHEEP OR GOATS!

LIMITS YOU MUST CONSIDER...

- Your age, health, and longevity
- Proper land and facilities on hand or attainable
- Labor availability or need
- Sustainable forage systems
- Control of parasites
- Other resources available

THE BOTTOM LINE...

Identify and Secure a Market-Build Adequate Facilities-Develop proper husbandry skills-Identify the type and kind of sheep or goats to raise-Deal with reputable breeders-Secure All Funding (Cash Preferred)-Start small and grow your operation to match your skill set and time constraints-

BEFORE BUYING THE FIRST ANIMAL!

Always Cover Your Backside!
