## **Driving Directions (GPS Coordinates: 33.339621, -88.550771)**

### **From Columbus:**

- From the intersection of US Hwy 82 and US Hwy 45 on the west side of Columbus, take Hwy 45 South toward Macon approximately 8 miles and turn right on Firetower Rd. Travel about 3/4 mile to metal building on right inside fenced compound area.

### **From Brooksville:**

- From the split at US Hwy 45 and US Hwy 45A, take US Hwy 45 North toward Columbus approximately 7.5 miles and turn left on Firetower Rd. Travel about 3/4 mile to metal building on right inside fenced compound area.

### **From Crawford:**

- From US Hwy 45A, turn east onto Tarlton Rd approximately 2.5 miles, then turn left on Nick Hairston Rd. Travel to end of road, turn right onto Firetower Rd, and immediately look for metal building on left inside fenced compound area.
