Membership:

- Be committed to the 4-H program.
- Must be 8 years old by January 1, of the current year.
- Maintain positive communication with county extension agent with 4-H responsibilities.

Retained Membership:

- Attend scheduled MSE-ES county 4-H Ambassador Trainings.
- Be committed to the 4-H program.
- Participate in MSU-ES County 4-H Ambassador planned events.

County 4-H Ambassadors, Education Program

- Quarterly leadership training will be conducted.
- Leadership curriculums will be provided

- Service Learning Projects
- Personal Development/Character Education
- Manners and Etiquette
- Parliamentary Procedure
