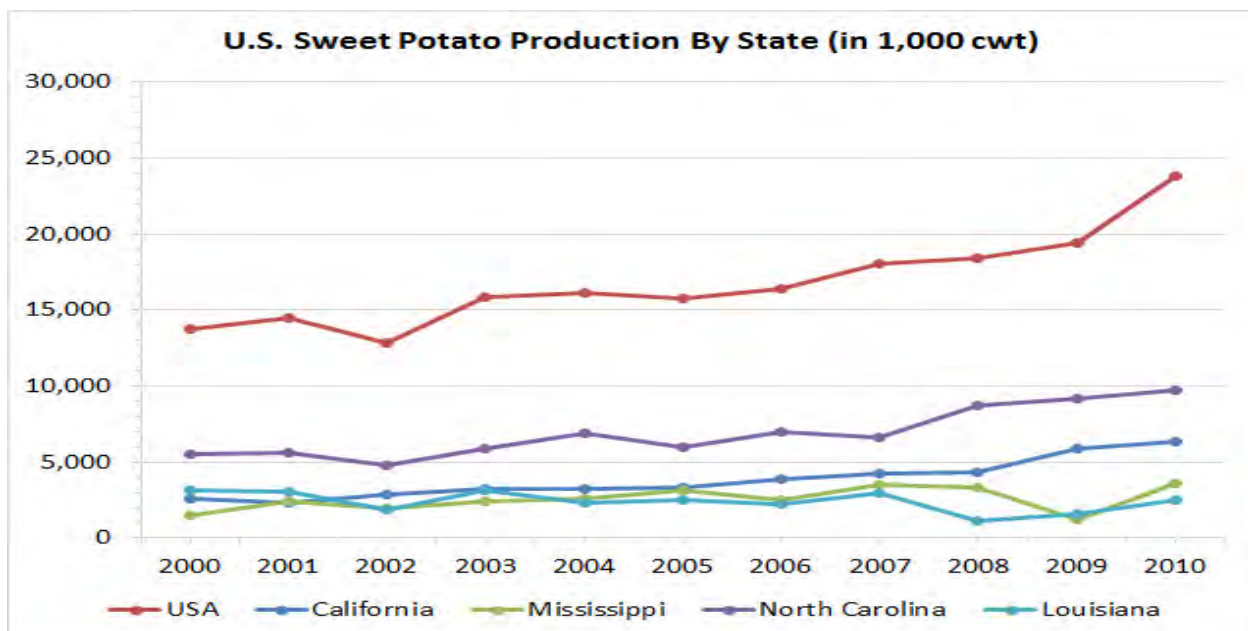

U.S. Sweet Potato Production

Based on the annual data published by USDA-Economic Research Service, total sweet potato production consistently increased from 13.7 million cwt in 2000 to 23.8 million cwt in 2010, as shown in the figure below. The top four producing states are North Carolina, California, Mississippi and Louisiana. Mississippi's sweet potato production averaged 2.5 million cwt since 2000 consisting of about 15 percent of total U.S. production.



Farms Growing Sweet Potatoes Which Are Registered In MarketMaker

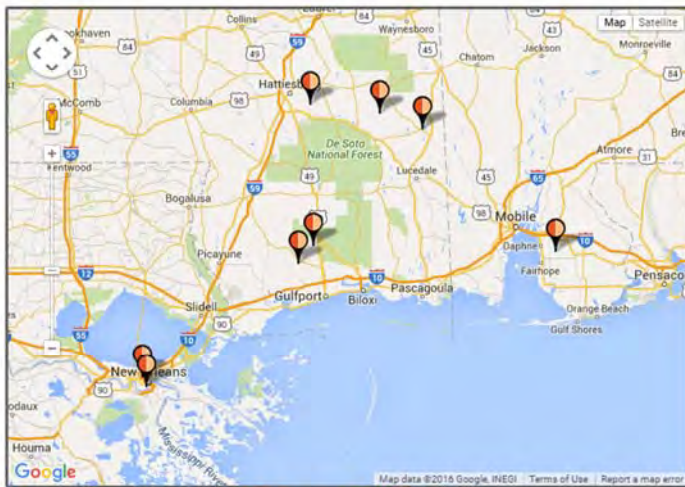
There are **754 farms** registered in the National Food MarketMaker program which indicated that they were growing sweet potatoes, as shown in the MarketMaker map below. When the search was narrowed to Mississippi, the number of farms growing sweet potatoes was **28**.
