Good afternoon! Attached is the May 2015 Operator Training Newsletter for all MSDH-BPWS Regions and following this message are the trainings for your particular region. If you have questions about the counties in your MSDH region, please see the map on the second page of the attachment to this e-mail.

Also, remember to please contact the training agency to make sure the training will be held. The information contained in this document was gathered from the MSDH-BPWS Training Calendar, so we have no information about if a particular training may be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances.

George Hinnant, Larry Murphree, and Bill Rutledge provided a presentation that included the following information for this article regarding the duties and responsibilities of certified water and wastewater operators. We would like to thank them for their contribution and for continuing to support water and wastewater operators throughout the state.

All public water systems in MS must be operated by a certified operator according to the Safe Drinking Water Act of 1997. An operator must earn Continuing Education Units (CEUs) to maintain and renew his/her license. Water operators must earn 12 Regulatory hours and 36 Non-Regulatory CEU hours for certification terms of 0 – 3 years, 3 – 6 years, and 6 – 9 years. Wastewater operators must earn 12 Regulatory and 12 Non-Regulatory CEU hours for certifications of 9 or more continuous years.

General responsibilities for certified water operators include:

- Develop and follow Standard Operating Procedures for the system
- Recording Master meter readings, capacity and production
- Monitoring chlorine dosage/residual and other chemical feed equipment
- Preventative and corrective maintenance on all pumps, wells, and other assets including exercising valves, maintaining lines, flushing, and scheduling tank inspection/maintenance
- Maintaining accurate MSDH logbook/records
- Enforce all water system policies including cross-connection control programs and cut-off procedures
- Prepare all annual reports, samples and sample reports, site plans, CCRs
- Operate system within compliance of all Safe Drinking Water Act regulations
- Practice emergency response plans and procedures including emergency contact information, procedures, assign duties/responsibilities to specific employees, and plan for recovery of the system
- Supervise and guide employees as necessary
- Monitor system in accordance with MSDH minimum visitation requirements

We encourage you to share this information with new operators, employees, and board members. Thank each of you for your hard work and dedication.
