To: Public Water System Officials
 From: Mississippi State Department of Health, Bureau of Public Water Supply and Division of On-site Wastewater
 Subject: Internal Agency Changes
 Purpose: To inform the public that changes have occurred, effective March 1, 2016, for the processes involving:

- A "new" public water meter NOTE: For homes needing an Individual On-site Wastewater Disposal System
- Evaluation of property for an Individual On-site Wastewater Disposal System NOTE: For homes that do not have access to a central wastewater collection system
- A request to inspect an "existing" Individual On-site Wastewater Disposal System
- A request for a private water well sample
- Filing a wastewater complaint

Do not visit the local county Health Department to fill out a request (paperwork) for the above. A **new** online application process has been developed. See below for details.

Step 1: File a Complete Application. The application forms for "new" on-site wastewater systems are now online;

- Step 2: <u>Return documents</u>. Email or mail to the physical location (see contact information and map below);
- **Step 3:** <u>Pay Fees.</u> Once we receive a complete application, including a <u>plot plan</u> and <u>legal description</u>, you will receive an email link to an online payment system. Follow the link to pay your fee; and
- **Step 4:** When your payment is successful, one of our inspectors will contact you to schedule a site visit, if necessary. If you do not receive a call within 48 hours of your receipt, then please contact us.

If you need assistance with completing an application, please contact the toll-free Wastewater Call Center at 1-855-220-0192. Call Center personnel will answer your questions, assist you with completion of forms, and assist you with our new on line payment system.


