

Interior Design Contest

Design Board must include the following items mounted on the black presentation board is 13x20 and the white board is 11x18:

- Furniture Arrangement: A template for the room is being attached, plus furniture templates. The furniture layout will be judged on creativity, proper use of space and lighting, neatness, and drawn to scale. The attached templates are drawn to scale. (*Seniors Only*)
- Color Scheme: Chose a color scheme for your room. This color scheme will be reflected in the samples that you use on your board.
- Flooring, wall treatments, and ceilings: Use swatches of carpet, flooring samples, paint samples, or sample wall treatments (free at most building supply stores). Mount these to board to show what type floor and wall treatments you will use. YOU MUST HAVE 1 EXAMPLE OF EACH: FLOOR, AND WALLS. You may have more, example: ceilings, or 2 different wall treatments in one room.
- Fabrics: 2 swatches of fabric that will be used in the room.
- Back of board: Name, County, and Level
- Label any swatches of fabric, paint, or floor samples for there use. Examples: Pillows, curtains, comforter, dust ruffle...)

Design Board Presentation

- Tell whom you designed the room for? (Child, adult, teen)
- Tell what type of color scheme you are using in the room.
- Seniors only tell about the furniture arrangement and about the traffic patterns of the room. Also tell how you applied the principles of design to your plan.
- Tell what type of floor and wall treatments will be used. (carpet, tile, wallpaper or paint ext...)
- Tell how the fabrics you chose will be used in the room.
- Tell what you like most about this room.
- Neatness of Board
