## **Application for 4-H Club Charter**

4-H is the youth development organization of the land-grant system.

In accordance with federal regulation, each 4-H club will be chartered beginning May 1, 2005. The 4-H club charter identifies the group as eligible to use the name and emblem of 4-H, and to participate in official 4-H activities and educational programs.

To receive a charter, this application is to be completed, then signed by the president of the 4-H club, the 4-H club volunteer leader, and the Extension 4-H youth agent. If there is not a 4-H staff member in the county, the signature of the Extension county coordinator is needed. The county Extension staff will then forward the application to the Extension Associate Director, 4-H Youth Development at Box 9601, Mississippi State, MS 39762, for approval. The associate director will issue the charter.

Presentation of the 4-H club charter may be made during some formal occasion, during a meeting of the county 4-H club council, or at the next meeting of the 4-H club.
