
Constructing an Archery Stand



Following are step-by-step instructions for constructing an economical stand for archery bag targets.

Materials needed:

Five 33-inch pieces of 1-inch square steel tubing



One 12-inch piece of 1/2-inch square steel tubing



Four 1/2-inch flat washers












Two 1/4-inch quick links



Two swivel bolt snaps




Parts:

Step 1: Make sure that each main piece of 1-inch square steel tubing is 33 inches long.

Step 2: Directions for constructing the top piece.

A. Cut two 1-inch-long pieces from the 1/2-inch steel tubing. **B**. Weld the small pieces to one of the 33-inch long pieces of tubing. Weld the pieces flush on each end.



Assembly:

Step 1:

Take the side pieces and attach to each of the two bases. Make sure the washer on each side piece is placed toward the base and to the inside of the frame. The purpose of these washers is to serve as an attachment point for smaller target bags.





Step 2:
Attach top portion of frame to each of the two sides.





Step 3:
Attach bag to frame. After disassembly, the top piece can remain attached to target and used to transport the target.
